Due to the recent storm activities that traversed our county causing unusual amounts or rain, wind, and inclement weather, I would like to take this opportunity to inform you about agricultural damage assessment reporting and disaster assistance resources.

These forms will be compiled to report impacts and determine eligibility for federal and state support in conjunction with reporting to the local USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA).
